1. Welcome to our new members and Welcome Back to our returning members! I hope that everything has been well with all of you since last August. We have an exciting season of music and concerts planned for this season. Thank you to those of you present last week for your understanding and cooperation in regards to rehearsal's relocation. Hopefully we will not be surprised like that again this

Our performances this year will be at the **Warren Band Shell on Wednesday, July 21st** , another on **Thursday, August 12th for the Bristol "Concerts on the Common" Concert Series** and the last for our new **"Night at the Pops" Concert (Tentatively on Friday August, 13th) at the Our Lady of Light Band Club Hall in Fall River, MA** that will feature our adult wind ensemble and chorus as well. (More information will be disseminated in the weeks to come). Please remember to bring a wire music stand and clothespins to each concert.
5. **Section Leaders will be given the parts for each section when music is distributed.** (Section Leaders are designated members of the adult ensemble) It is at their discretion who receives what part, but they will be sure to be fair about allowing everyone a chance at 1st parts that wish and are able to play them. This will ensure that our instrumentation is well balanced! Please be patient with this process.
6. It looks a little bleak this year in regards to advertisements in our **program booklet** thusfar. Therefore, this year I have decided to save the work in preparing the booklet and just go with a one page flyer at each concert with concert repertoire, concert dates, etc. in it and no advertisements

We are now selling **advertisement placards to be displayed on our equipment trailer.** Each advertising placard is 12"-18" wide x 24"-36" long in size with up to 4 colors and is displayed for 3 years on the trailer for an initial cost of \$300 (renewable for subsequent 3 year periods for \$225).
