FROM PROVIDENCE (RT. 195)

- Follow RT 114 South into Warren
- Take a Right onto CHURCH ST (located just after St. Mary of the Bay Church at East Bay Bike Path Crossing)
- Take a Left onto WATER ST
- Burr's Hill Bandshell is on the left-hand side of the street

FROM WARREN and ALL POINTS NORTH of BRISTOL

- Take RT 195 to Massachusetts Exit 2 to RT 136 South
- Follow into Bristol and follow past the 8th set of lights
- Shortly after the 8th set of lights, take a right onto State Street
- Follow until the 4 way Stop Sign, Bristol Town Common is on your left-hand side across the street from St. Mary's Church

FROM PORTSMOUTH and ALL POINTS SOUTH of BRISTOL

- Follow RT 24, RT 114 or RT 136 to the Mt. Hope Bridge
- Go over the Mt. Hope Bridge into Bristol
- Follow RT 114 (Hope Street) for approx. three miles into Bristol (Requires you to take a left at the fork in front of Roger Williams University)
- Take a right onto State Street (Just before Dunkin' Donuts and Linden Place)
- Follow until the 4 way Stop Sign, Bristol Town Common is on your right-hand side across the street from Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church

Rain location: St. Mary's Church is located at 330 Wood Street directly across the street from the Bristol Town Common

- Travel a half of a mile North on **County Street (RT 138)**
- Turn left onto **Buffinton Street**
- St. Louis de France Parish is almost one mile west on Buffinton on the left

FROM BRISTOL/WARREN

- Travel South on **Metacom Ave. (RT 136)**
- Go over the **Mt. Hope Bridge**
- Go straight through the first set of lights and take a left at the second set of lights onto **RT 24 North**
- Travel on **RT 24 North** through **Rhode Island** into **Massachusetts**
- Take **Exit 2 (Brayton Ave. / Eastern Ave.)** and stay left at the split at the end of the ramp
- Go through to the second set of lights and take a right onto **Jefferson Street** (Katrina's Bakery on the corner)
- Continue straight on **Jefferson Street** which becomes **Quequechan Street** until you go under an overpass
- Once you go under the overpass take a left at the next street (**Quarry Street**)
- The Band Club is on you right-hand side across from **Party Dress Express / Planet Fitness**

FROM PROVIDENCE (RT. 195)

- Travel on **195 East**, going over the **Braga Bridge**
- Take **Exit 7 (Plymouth Ave. / Pleasant Street)** and stay to your left (**Plymouth Ave.**) at the end of the ramp when it splits
- Go left at the end of the ramp (McDonalds in front of you) where there is a tiny split at the lights
- Travel under the overpass and go through a set of lights. After passing a Burger King, you will reach another set of lights (CVS in front of you) where you will take a right onto **Pleasant Street**
- Travel on **Pleasant Street** until you reach you first set of light (shopping plaza with Hollywood Video on your right) where you will take a right onto **Quarry Street**
- Go down **Quarry Street** and the Band Club will be on your left-hand side across from **Party Dress Express / Planet Fitness**
